

2010 Santa Fe YAFL at McCurdy High School



We are pleased to announce that the Santa Fe Young American Football League will be coming to McCurdy High School for 2010. Registration fee will be \$140.00 which includes the player's jersey which he/she will keep upon completing the season. Some of the criteria is as follows:

Players must be between the age of 6-11 on or before August 31st of each season to be considered eligible for season play. There are no exceptions. Proof of age is required at the time of registration.

Division 1: 6, 7 & 8 year olds

Weight limit: 6, 7 & 8 year olds up to 100 lbs

Exceptions: 9 year old, 59 lbs or less may remain within this division

Division 2: 9 & 10 year olds

Weight limits: 9 & 10 year olds up to 150 lbs

Exceptions: 11 year old, 69 lbs or less may remain within this division

Division 3: 11 & 12 years old

Weight limits: 11 & 12 years olds up to 175 lbs

Exceptions 13 year old, 105 lbs or less, may remain with this division

As of right now we are hoping to fill a division 2 team. There is a possibility of doing a division 1 team if there is enough interest and coaches. Division 3 might also be a possibility as well. Practice would be at McCurdy High School starting in July 2010, while games will be in Santa Fe. Registration would be in the next month or so with a location to be announced. PARENT'S CODE OF ETHICS

I hereby pledge to provide positive support, care and encouragement for my child participating in youth sports by following this code of ethics.

- I will encourage good sportsmanship by demonstrating positive support for all players, coaches and officials at every game, practice or other youth sports event.
- I will place the emotional and physical well being of my child ahead of any personal desire to win.
- I will insist that my child play in a safe and healthy environment.
- I will provide support for coaches and officials working with my child to provide a positive, enjoyable experience for all.
- I will demand a drug, alcohol and tobacco-free sports environment for my child and agree to assist by refraining from their use at all sports events.
- I will remember that the game is for children and not for adults.
- I will do my very best to make youth sports fun for my child.
- I will ask my child to treat other players, coaches, fans and officials with respect regardless of race, sex, creed or ability.
- I will promise to help my child enjoy the youth sports experience within my personal constraints by assisting with coaching, being a respectful fan, providing transportation or whatever I am capable of doing.
- A parent or guardian must attend a commissioner meeting for each player. Otherwise the player will not be eligible for play until a parent attends a meeting.
- I will provide transportation to and from practices/games and I understand that I am expected to pick up my child promptly after every game/practice, to avoid putting the coach in a position where he is waiting beyond the set time after practice/game.
- I will report any grievances to the Coach, and/or Assistant Coach, within 24 hours of the occurrence of the incident, before going to any YAFL Staff. I will follow the grievance process set forth in the YAFL handbook.
- By signing this Code of Ethics, I am expected to inform all persons that will attend any practices or games of these rules. This includes any other parents, family members and friends.
- I will adhere to all rules, guidelines, policies and procedures set forth in the YAFL Handbook.
